EXPERIENCE LEVEL

Advanced Beginner

MATERIALS

- Blue Sky Hand Spun Organic Cotton (68 g/132 yds): 1 hank
- Size I (5.5 mm) crochet hook, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry Needle

Photo Shown: 60 Natural Cream

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Flower Motif Section: 10³/₄"

Ties: 22¹/₄" (each)

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg: Begin(ning)

Ch(s): Chain(s)

Cont: Continue(ing)

Dc: Double crochet

Dec: Decrease

Dec 1: Decrease 1 in single crochet (insert hk in first st, yarn over hk and pull through to front of work, insert hk in next st, yarn over hk and pull through to front of work, yarn over hk and pull through all 3 lps on hk)

Hk: Hook

Inc: Increase

Lp(s): Loop(s)

Rep: Repeat

Sc: Single crochet

St(s): Stitch(es)

Tch(s): Turning chain(s)

6-PETAL FLOWER MOTIF

Ch 6, sl st into 1st ch to form ring.

Round 1: Ch 1, work 12 sc into ring, sl st. into 1st sc.

Round 2: Ch 3, work 4 dc into same stitch as last sl st until 1 loop of each dc remains on hook, yo pull through all 5 loops on hook (bobble made), *ch 5, skip 1 sc, work 5 dc into next sc until 1 loop of each dc remains on hook, yo pull through all 6 loops on hook (bobble made), rep from * 4 times more, ch 5, sl st into top of first bobble. Fasten off leaving long tail (about 10")

Make 4 motifs total.

Use long tails to whip stitch motifs together along ch 5 spaces. Weave in all loose end.

FINISHING

Cut a length of yarn 6¹/₂ yds long. Fold in half and bring looped end through ch 5 space of headbands outer edge, pull two hanging strands through the loop to attach tie to headband. (This is like attaching fringe.) Using yarn doubled, ch 83, sl st in 3rd ch from hook. Fasten off and weave in end. Repeat for other side of headband. 🐾
